FACT SHEET no. (7.1) COMMERCIAL care/maintenance

CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR NEWLY COMPLETED SEAMLESS FLOOR:

Note:

Duron recommend a minimum of 24 hours before any foot traffic and a minimum of 7 days for any vehicles or heavy furniture. We highly recommend that carpet squares or similar be placed under furniture and tyres whilst floor is curing.

Note: Whilst coatings are tyre resistant and most tyres do not mark; there can be no guarantees against Tyre Chemical Bleed, leaving protection under tyres indefinitely is advisable.

Regular Cleaning (Standard Flakes) / Maintenance:

Broom or vacuum when required, if heavily soiled scrub floor with a recommended mild detergent and soft broom or commercial scrubbing machine, then hose out or mop allowing to dry.

Regular Cleaning (Stone Grip/Non-slip) / Maintenance:

With a textured surface, this is prone to catch debris. Level of maintenance will vary dependant on how soiled the floor is. A Commercial kitchen for example would be rinsed down with hot water, scrubbing with a mildly stiff broom. Add a commercial grade mild detergent, scrub with a broom, rinse off with hot water. Allow to dry or use a Wet/Dry vacuum to remove excess water, less soiled areas may not require as much broom scrubbing.

Major Maintenance:

Duron recommends a professional installer inspects the coated surface around the 3-year period or sooner if the coating is showing signs of wear; the floor may require a commercial machine scrub wash, light sanding and a further 1 or 2 coats of reglaze to maintain and keep the coated surface in pristine condition.
